

Health and Social Care Introductory - KS4

Overview

The following curriculum has been designed to support students who are studying the BTEC Level 1 Introductory Award or Certificate in Health and Social Care. This curriculum has been designed in line with the program specification.

The Pearson BTEC Level 1 Introductory qualifications give learners the opportunity to acquire and develop generic, transferable and sector-specific skills in order to complete tasks and demonstrate a level of achievement that enables them to progress to further learning.

For the Level 1 Award, two units must be achieved, one of which must be Developing a Personal Progression Plan (Group A) and one unit from the sector options (Group B) – see specification.

For the Level 1 Certificate, five units must be achieved, two of which must be the core units; Developing a Personal Progression Plan and Being Organised (Group A) and three units from the sector options (Group B) – see specification.
