

Health and Social Care Tech Award - KS4

Overview

Our KS4 students are given the opportunity to study a Level 1/2 Tech Award in Health and Social Care alongside their core subjects. This qualification is an introduction to vocational learning. It gives students the opportunity to build applied knowledge and skills that show an aptitude for further learning, both in the sector or more widely.

Health and Social Care is one of the fastest growing sectors in the UK with a demand for employees. Students will be given knowledge of their opportunities within different sectors of Health and Social Care. This BTEC qualification covers a wide range of topics including

- Human Lifespan Development (Component 1)
- Health and Social Care Services and Values (Component 2)
- Health and Wellbeing (Component 3)

Components 1 and 2 are assessed through non-exam internal assessment. These are designed to demonstrate application of the knowledge gained using realistic tasks and activities.

Component 3 is externally assessed and provides the main synoptic assessment for the qualification. This component builds on components 1 and 2 - enabling learning to be brought together and applied to realistic contexts.
