

ASDAN - KS3 / 4 Overview

This Employability qualification provides students with an opportunity to develop and recognise general employability skills.

It has been designed to help students to develop the skills needed to become successful employees. The primary purpose of this qualification is to support them in overcoming barriers to entering work. It is primarily intended for young people and adults who are not yet ready for employment but for whom a job is a realistic aim within a reasonable timescale.

Award

The number of guided learning hours required for the Award is 48 hours. Candidates must complete 6 credits worth of units in total, and must include at least one unit from the Core units group. The remainder of the credits can be achieved through either Core or Additional units.

Certificate

The number of guided learning hours required for the Certificate is 120 hours. Candidates must complete 15 credits worth of units in total, and must include at least two units from the Core units group. The remainder of the credits can be achieved through either Core or Additional units.
